Second Quarter, 2022

Balance of Payments

The country's current account deficit widened by 9.7 per cent to KSh 174.4 billion in the second quarter of 2022 from KSh 158.9 billion in the same quarter of 2021 as shown in Table 1. Similarly, merchandise trade, a major driver of the current account, recorded a deficit of KSh 365.6 billion in the quarter under review, an increase of 34.6 per cent from the corresponding quarter of 2021. The marked increase in merchandise trade deficit was mainly occasioned by a 31.7 per cent growth in imports on f.o.b basis to KSh 594.3 billion, compared to a 27.4 per cent increase in exports to KSh 228.7 billion. Elevated oil prices increased the import value of petroleum products thereby pushing the import bill during the second quarter of 2022. Export earnings from tea increased on account of improved international prices due to increased demand during the quarter under review. Other drivers of growth in exports were coffee, and titanium ores and concentrates.

During the second quarter of 2022, international services exports were KSh 214.0 billion, an increase of 81.2 per cent from KSh 118.1 billion recorded in a similar quarter of 2021. Similarly, services imports were valued at KSh 154.7 billion from KSh 105.4 billion in the second quarter of 2021. As a consequence, international trade in services balance improved to a surplus of KSh 59.3 billion from a surplus of KSh 12.7 billion in the same quarter of 2021. Receipts from transport and travel services continued to boost the surplus in the services account. Kenyans living abroad sent home KSh 120.3 billion in the second quarter of 2022, an increase of 18.7 per cent from the corresponding quarter of 2021.

Net financial inflows decreased by 10.4 per cent from a surplus of KSh 282.5 billion in the second quarter of 2021 to KSh 253.0 billion in the second quarter of 2022. Similarly, the stock of gross official reserves declined by 6.8 per cent to KSh 1,001.0 billion in the quarter under review. The Kenya Shilling continued to weaken against the dollar to exchange at KSh117.83 to the dollar at the end of the second quarter

of 2022 compared to an exchange rate of KSh107.85 to the dollar at the end of the same quarter of 2021. The overall Balance of Payments position recorded a surplus of KSh 10.9 billion in the quarter under review compared to a surplus of KSh 179.8 billion recorded in the second quarter of 2021, a decrease of 93.9 per cent.

Public and Publicly Guaranteed External Debt

The stock of external public and publicly guaranteed debt continued to rise from KSh 3,999.5 billion at the end of June 2021 to KSh 4,290.7 billion, representing a 7.3 per cent increase over the period as highlighted in Table 2. Outstanding public debt accounted for 50.0 per cent of the total stock of public and publicly guaranteed debt at the end of June 2022.

Multilateral sources remained the leading, accounting for 44.8 per cent of the stock of external debt at the end of June 2022, having risen by KSh 291.9 billion from June 2021. Commercial sources continued to be the second, accounting for 27.5 per cent of the stock of external debt at the end of June 2022. This was despite a marginal decline in the stock of debt from KSh 1,187.4 billion at the end of June 2021 to KSh 1,181.3 billion at the end of June 2022. Bilateral debt rose by 2.9 per cent to KSh 1,173.2 billion at the end of June 2022.

International Merchandise Trade

The volume of trade grew from KSh 663.9 billion in the second quarter of 2021 to KSh 886.5 billion in the second quarter of 2022, representing a 33.5 per cent increase, as presented in Figure 1 and Table 3. During the review period, total exports earnings amounted to KSh 228.4 billion, reflecting a 27.3 per cent increase compared to the corresponding quarter of 2021. This was largely driven by increases in domestic exports of tea; coffee; and titanium ores and concentrates. Similarly, import expenditure rose by 35.8 per cent to KSh 658.1 billion in the second quarter of 2022, largely attributable to increased import of petroleum products. However, international merchandise trade balance widened to a deficit of KSh 429.7 billion in the second quarter of 2022 from a deficit of KSh 305.1 billion recorded in the corresponding quarter of 2021.

Figure 1: International Merchandise Trade Balance, 2nd Quarter, 2020-2022



Value of Domestic Exports




Figure 2: Domestic Exports of Selected Commodities, 2nd Quarter, 2020-2022

Earnings from domestic exports increased by 24.9 per cent from KSh 163.3 billion in the second quarter of 2021 to KSh 204.0 billion in the period under review. The increase was largely attributable to significant increases in the value of domestic exports of tea, coffee; and titanium ores and concentrates, as shown in Annex 1 and Figure 2. Revenue from domestic exports of tea rose from KSh 32.2 billion in the second quarter of 2021 to KSh 40.3 billion in the second quarter of 2022, mainly attributed to improved tea prices in the international markets from KSh 220.6 per kilogramme in the second quarter of 2021 to KSh 291.8 per kilogramme in the corresponding quarter of 2022.

Earnings from domestic exports of titanium ores and concentrates more than doubled to KSh 10.7 billion over the same period. In addition, revenue from domestic exports of unroasted coffee rose by 67.9 per cent to KSh 12.7 billion, in the period under review. Conversely, the value of domestic exports of horticultural products dropped to KSh 39.4 billion in the second quarter of 2022 from KSh 41.5 billion recorded in a similar quarter of 2021, translating to a 5.2 per cent decline.

Under the Broad Economic Category (BEC) classification, the bulk of revenue from domestic exports was attributable to exports of food and beverage commodities which accounted for 43.6 per cent of the domestic export earnings, in the quarter under review, as presented in Annex 7. Non-food industrial supplies registered the highest increase in export earnings at 48.1 per cent from KSh 40.4 billion in the second quarter of 2021 to KSh 59.9 billion in the second quarter of 2022.

Value of Imports

During the second quarter of 2022, import expenditure went up by 35.8 per cent to KSh 658.1 billion compared to the corresponding quarter of 2021. The remarkable increase was occasioned majorly by an increase in import bill of petroleum products which rose from KSh 70.2 billion in the second quarter of 2021 to KSh 168.3 billion in the review period, as shown in Figure 3. Notably, the value of imported animal and vegetable oils went up from KSh 26.0 billion in second quarter of 2021 to KSh 42.7 billion reflecting an increase of 64.5 per cent.

Moreover, other imported commodities that contributed to the increase in import expenditure include organic and inorganic chemicals; wheat; iron and steel; and industrial machinery which increased by 55.8, 45.6, 19.3 and 8.5 per cent, respectively.

Similarly, there was a surge in the volume imports of maize, which more than tripled from 59.1 thousand tonnes in the second quarter of 2021 to 223.5 thousand tonnes in the second quarter of 2022. Consequently, expenditure on imported maize rose significantly from KSh 1.5 billion to KSh 6.2 billion over the same period as highlighted in Annex 4.

Analysis by Broad Economic Category (BEC) classification showed that the value of imported non-food industrial supplies accounted for 37.0 per cent of the total import bill, while fuel and lubricants accounted for 27.3 per cent of the total import value in the second quarter of 2022, as presented in Annex 8. The highest increase in the value of imports was registered in fuel and lubricants, which increased from KSh 82.6 billion in second quarter of 2021 to KSh 180.0 billion in the second quarter of 2022.

Direction of International Merchandise Trade

During the second quarter of 2022, total exports grew by 27.3 per cent from KSh 179.4 billion in the corresponding quarter of 2021 to KSh 228.4 billion, as displayed in Annex 5. The largest portion of export earnings were from the African continent valued at KSh 90.5 billion, representing 39.6 per cent of the total value of exports. This was boosted by increase in exports to Rwanda (64.3%), Tanzania (48.7%), South Sudan (74.9%) and Egypt (49.6%). In contrast, total exports to the Democratic Republic of Congo exhibited a marked decline from KSh 12.6 billion in the second quarter of 2021 to KSh 4.3 billion in the review period, largely occasioned by decreased domestic exports of cut flowers and tea.

Export earnings from the European Union increased by 24.7 per cent to KSh 35.0 billion in the second quarter of 2022. This was partly as a result of increase in re-exports of kerosene type jet fuel to the Netherlands and domestic exports of coffee to Germany. Similarly, in the same period, income from exports to Asia increased by 49.1 per cent to KSh 55.2 billion, largely contributed by increase in domestic exports of tea and re-exports of kerosene type jet fuel to the United Arab Emirates. Moreover, the United States of America overtook Uganda to become the leading export destination accounting for 10.9 per cent of the total export value in the second quarter of 2022. This was mainly occasioned by increase in domestic exports of titanium ores and concentrates, coffee and macadamia nuts.

The total value of imports in the second quarter of 2022 amounted to KSh 658.1 billion, an increase of 35.8 per cent from the same quarter of 2021, as presented in Annex 6. The largest proportion of the import expenditure was attributable to Asia, accounting for 72.2 per cent of the total import bill. Far East Asia remained the largest source of imports with the value of imports from China accounting for 37.1 per cent of the total value of imports from this region. Increased imports of gas oil from India resulted to a 47.5 per cent growth in imports from this source while imports of crude palm oil from Malaysia drove the growth in imports from this country, which more than doubled. The increase in palm oil imports was partly a result of international demand for the product which shored up the price of the commodity, with the highest price recorded in April 2022. In the Middle East, expenditure on imports from Saudi Arabia and the United Arab Emirates rose significantly, partly due to increase in the import value of kerosene type jet fuel and motor spirit (gasoline) premium, respectively, in the second quarter of 2022.

In Eastern Europe, imports from the Russian Federation and Ukraine declined by 54.6 per cent and 92.9 per cent, respectively, largely due to the disruptions caused by Russia's invasion in Ukraine since February 2022.

In the review period, the value of imports from Africa amounted to KSh 66.0 billion, increasing from KSh 52.3 billion in the corresponding quarter of 2021. This trend was driven by increased imports of maize from Tanzania and milk from Uganda. In the same period, import expenditure from America increased by 68.4 per cent to KSh 38.2 billion. The growth was largely due to increase in imports of petroleum gases, vaccines for human medicine and aircraft engines from the United States of America.

On the contrary, imports from Australia dropped from KSh 15.9 billion in the second quarter of 2021 to KSh 13.6 billion in the review period. This was mainly occasioned by significant decrease in imports of grain sorghum; wheat and meslin.
